ROAD TRANSFERS: Shipwreck Lodge road transfers are included in the FI rate and depart Mowe Bay at 15h00 for camp and depart camp for Mowe Bay at around 07h30 to arrive for 09h00. Road transfers between Shipwreck Lodge and Hoanib Valley Camp charged at N\$ 2,000 per person each way. Self-drive guests park at Mowe Bay car port and transfer to the lodge.

EXCURSION DETAILS: At this time the following excursions are available.

- Sundowner drive to the roaring dunes - This afternoon excursion by vehicle to the Oasis Water Point ends in the smoothly sculptured roaring dunes of the concession.
- Full day Hoarusib River excursion - Guests will be driven in an open 4X4 vehicle to see the renowned Clay Castles, a natural geological formation where brown hyenas are often encountered. An opportunity to see the elusive lion and desert adapted elephant.
- Day excursion to Mowe Bay seal colony; On the way guests will see the remnants of the Suiderkus shipwreck, remains of the Karimona shipwreck, an abandoned diamond mine, remains of the Ventura Bomber and the beautiful natural wind shelter created by the reeds at the Flamingo Pools.
- Fishing
- Beach lunch (weather permitting)

CHILDREN:

- Shipwreck Lodge accept children of all ages
- Private vehicles must be booked for families with children 12 and younger

CHILD PRICES:

- Children 0 - 5 years accommodated free of charge, sharing with adults
