Due to its extraordinary beauty and seclusion, Lekkerwater was chosen to be ex-President FW De Klerk's 'Camp David'. The Lekkerwater experience of today builds on the area's natural charm and the fabulous 6km long beach that dominates the scenery and complements the marine reserve offshore. On offer at Lekkerwater Beach Lodge are two or three night stays with guaranteed departures every Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Everyone arrives on the same day and experiences this incredible journey of fun and discovery together. We will explore the natural wonders of this amazing destination with expert guides and a range of exciting activities that focus on the 6km of pristine beach, interspersed with fynbos walks on the surrounding hills, marine explorations, rock pool swimming, bird watching, star gazing, beach braais and time in our wood-fired hot tub on the beach. Lekkerwater is at the heart of De Hoop Bay which enjoys some of the highest concentration of whales anywhere on earth. During the whale season (July to November) there are usually anywhere from 6 to upwards of 20 whales in view directly in front of Lekkerwater Beach Lodge at any one time. And the dolphins are here all year.

INCLUSIONS: All prices quoted are per person per night and include all accommodation on a sharing basis; all meals, all local house wines, beers, spirits and cool drinks, road transfers to/from the lodge's car park 6km away, all daily activities and VAT.

EXCLUSIONS: The cost of getting to Lekkerwater Beach Lodge's car park, road transfers from De Hoop airstrip in the west of the reserve (about an hour's drive away), park entrance fees payable as you enter the park (currently ZAR 50 pppn), premium brand drinks, guest laundry gratuities and fully comprehensive personal travel insurance. During whale season, it may be possible to charter a helicopter for scenic aerial whale watching. The cost of this is excluded.

Included in these published rates is a conservation contribution, which is collected by Natural Selection Safaris on behalf of the Natural Selection Conservation Trust. The conservation contribution is separately itemised on all invoices and is non-vatable.

Conservation, Community and Reserve Fee

Over and above the 1.5% included in our turnover that is collected on behalf of the Natural Selection Trust for conservation work, Natural Selection have introduced a per person per night Conservation, Community and Reserve Fee. This non-refundable fee secures funds that are crucial to our areas of operation for protecting wildlife, wildlife habitat, supporting communities as well as managing reserves and concessions. Uses include anti-poaching patrols, wildlife monitoring, community upliftment and royalties, human-wildlife conflict mitigation, land management and conservation education. The Conservation, Community and Reserve Fee is not applicable for children aged 0-5 years but does apply to children 6 years and older as well as pilots/guides.

ITINERARY:

Arrivals every Monday, Wednesday (for 2 night stays) and Friday (for 3 night stays)
 Minimum 2 night stay

AIR TRANSFERS:

- Helicopter transfers are possible (subject to approval), the landing area is 200 meters to the east of the lodge. Charter flights will need to land at De Hoop Airstrip in the west of the reserve (about 1,5 hrs away). A transfer fee of ZAR 980 per person each way will apply.

ROAD TRANSFERS:

- A return road transfer from Cape Town to Lekkerwater Beach Lodge is available to book for a maximum of 3 guests at ZAR 8800 per vehicle to get guests to Lekkerwater and back to Cape Town.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:

- Guests should arrive at Lekkerwater's car park at 14:00 for the scheduled transfer to the lodge

- Departure time from the lodge is scheduled for 10:15

PARK ENTRANCE:

- Access to Lekkerwater is via the Potberg Park Entrance (not the "Morukuru and De Hoop Collection entrance gate"). From the Potberg entrance gate it is 14.6km (approximately 40 minutes drive) to the Lekkerwater's car park. De Hoop Nature Reserve Gates open at 07:30 and close at 16:00. Gate entrance fee of ZAR 50 per person (as at publication), per night is payable in cash upon entry. Please note that there are no credit card facilities available.

CHILDREN:

- Children 6 and above are welcome

- Children 6 18 years sharing the family room with adults pay 50% of the accommodation rate
- Children 6 18 years charged 50% of the per person adult accommodation rate per night (sharing with adults)
- Children 6 18 years will be charged as per normal adult rates for any additional extras not included in our fully inclusive rate
- Children in their own room please contact reservations for a quote
- Guests 19 years and over charged full adult rate
