INCLUSIONS: All prices quoted are per person per night and include all accommodation on a sharing basis; all meals, all local house wines, beers, spirits and cool drinks, Wi-Fi, road transfers to/from the lodge's car park 6km away, all daily activities and VAT.

EXCLUSIONS: The cost of getting to Lekkerwater Beach Lodge's car park, park entrance fees payable as you enter the park (currently ZAR 50 pppn), premium brand drinks, guest laundry, gratuities and fully comprehensive personal travel insurance. During whale season, it may be possible to charter a helicopter for scenic aerial whale watching. The cost of this is excluded.

ITINERARY

- Arrivals every Monday, Wednesday or Friday (minimum stay of 2 nights – optimal up to 4 nights).
- Please note that on a Wednesday arrival we can offer 2, 4 or 5 night stays.
- During the Festive peak season a minimum 3 night stay may apply over certain periods (20 December & 27 December).

CHILD RATE

- Children 6 and above are welcome.
- Children 6 - 18 years sharing the family room (maximum 2 children) with two adults pay 50% of the accommodation rate.
- Children 6 - 18 years charged 50% of the per person adult accommodation rate per night if sharing with an adult (maximum 1 child sharing with an adult per standard room).
- Children 12 - 18 years in their own room to please contact reservations for a quote.
- Guests 19 years and over charged full adult rate.

ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE

- Guests driving to Lekkerwater should arrive at the Lekkerwater car park at 14h00 to be in time for the scheduled transfer to the lodge in the lodge's 4x4 vehicle. Lunch at the lodge is not included on arrival day, so please ensure lunch is arranged en route and costed in/taken into account with timing. Our suggestion is to include a lunch stop in Napier or at the Square in Bredasdorp.
- **Whether travelling in the guests' own vehicle, booking a hired car or arranging a transfer by road, please ensure it is a vehicle with reasonably high clearance.**
- Departure time from the lodge is scheduled for 10h15.

AIR TRANSFERS

- Helicopter transfers from Cape Town are a recommended highlight for arrivals and/or departures. The helicopter landing area is 250 metres to the east of Lekkerwater, and landing times should be scheduled for 14h30.
- The closest airfield to Lekkerwater is the gravel airstrip in the western part of the De Hoop Reserve. About 1 hour and 40 minutes' drive from Lekkerwater, the transfer by road between Lekkerwater and the airfield is ZAR 4800 per vehicle, one way (maximum 6 guests and luggage). Aircraft arrival times should be scheduled to land at the De Hoop Airfield around midday (with the exact time to be finalised closer to the time to accommodate other guest's arrivals at Lekkerwater).

PARK ENTRANCE

- Vehicle access to Lekkerwater is via the Potberg park entrance of De Hoop Nature Reserve -not the "Morukuru and De Hoop Collection" entrance gate.
- The gates at Potberg open at 07h30 and close at 16h00. The gate entrance fee is currently ZAR 50 per person, per night and is payable upon entry to Cape Nature, either by cash or credit card.
- From the Potberg entrance gate, it is 14.6km (approximately 40 minutes' drive) to the Lekkerwater car park.

ROAD TRANSFERS

- Transfers to/from Cape Town take around three and a half hours.
- These are available on a request basis. Final costs are dependent on the pick-up point and the number of guests, but the base cost is from ZAR 9500 per vehicle, one way – excluding lunch en route.

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GweGwe Beach Lodge is on a 5,000-hectare private concession within the Mkambati Nature Reserve, Eastern Cape. Pristine rivers, tumbling waterfalls (inland and directly into the sea), deep gorges, rolling grasslands, pockets of dense swamp forest and beautiful secluded beaches are just some of the highlights of this superlative coastal destination. As a fully community owned and beneficiation project, the history of the Pondo people features throughout, with design inspiration coming from the traditional homes of the Transkei. Seven twin deluxe suites and two family suites blend into the environment - surrounded by sea, forests and rolling grasslands. Offering the ultimate escape, each suite has its' own lounge area, pool, deck, courtyard, tea/coffee station and mini bar. GweGwe Beach Lodge offers a wide range of facilities and activities. There are a variety of options to access this wonderfully remote hotspot of biodiversity – 5.5 hours self-drive from Durban or Umtata; scheduled or private light aircraft transfers; an exciting 75-minute boat ride from Port Edward; or scenic helicopter flights from Durban or Port Edward.

HOW TO GET TO GWEGWE BEACH LODGE

| Port Edward by Semi-rigid boat 75 mins : Monday & Friday | R2,225 per person return | Price valid for a minimum 2 or more guests |

A 75-minute adventure boat trip from Port Edward to GweGwe Beach Lodge. Departs every Friday and Monday in a 12-seater semi-rigid, twin engined boat. Check in at Port Edward at 10.30am. (Durban to Port Edward is around a 2 hour 15-minute drive). Private boat transfer charters are available any day. Luggage allowance is 20kgs per person maximum.

Fly from Durban's Virginia Airport to the Mkambati Airfield in a Cessna 206, Cessna Caravan or similar. The scheduled flight departs Virginia Airport every Friday at 7.30am. Luggage allowance is 20kgs per person maximum. Alternatively, private charters can be arranged for any day of the week.

The R44 is a pilot plus three seater helicopter based in Margate that can depart anytime to suit your arrangements. It can fly with 2 passengers plus 20kgs of luggage per person maximum. Private helicopter flights are available any day from Durban.
