Due to its extraordinary beauty and seclusion, Lekkerwater was chosen to be ex-President FW De Klerk's 'Camp David'. The Lekkerwater experience of today builds on the area's natural charm and the fabulous 6km long beach that dominates the scenery and complements the marine reserve offshore. On offer at Lekkerwater Beach Lodge are two or three night stays with guaranteed departures every Monday, Wednesday and Friday. Everyone arrives on the same day and experiences this incredible journey of fun and discovery together. We will explore the natural wonders of this amazing destination with expert guides and a range of exciting activities that focus on the 6km of pristine beach, interspersed with fynbos walks on the surrounding hills, marine explorations, rock pool swimming, bird watching, star gazing, beach braais and time in our wood-fired hot tub on the beach. Lekkerwater is at the heart of De Hoop Bay which enjoys some of the highest concentration of whales anywhere on earth. During the whale season (July to November) there are usually anywhere from 6 to upwards of 20 whales in view directly in front of Lekkerwater Beach Lodge at any one time. And the dolphins are here all year.

Notes: Please note all of our rates must be read in conjunction with our camp fact sheets.

INCLUSIONS: All prices quoted are per person per night and include all accommodation on a sharing basis; all meals, all local house wines, beers, spirits and cool drinks, road transfers to/from the lodge's car park 6km away, all daily activities and VAT.

EXCLUSIONS: The cost of getting to Lekkerwater Beach Lodge's car park, road transfers from De Hoop airstrip in the west of the reserve (about an hour's drive away), park entrance fees payable as you enter the park, premium brand drinks, gratuities and fully comprehensive personal travel insurance. During whale season, it may be possible to charter a helicopter for scenic aerial whale watching. The cost of this is excluded.

Included in the published rate is a conservation contribution, which is collected by Natural Selection Safaris on behalf of a Not for Profit Conservation Trust. The contribution will be separately itemised on all invoices.

SHOULDER SEASON: 01 May - 14 July

HIGH SEASON: 10 January - 30 April | 15 July - 19 December

CHRISTMAS PEAK SEASON: 20 December - 09 January 2022

#### ITINERARY:

Arrivals every Monday, Wednesday (for 2 night stays) and Friday (for 3 night stays) Minimum 2 night stay

#### AIR TRANSFERS:

Helicopter transfers are possible, the landing area is 200 meters away from the lodge. Charter flights will need to land at De Hoop Airstrip in the west of the reserve (about an hour's drive away). A transfer fee of ZAR 750 per person each way will apply.

#### ROAD TRANSFERS:

A return road transfer from Cape Town to Lekkerwater Beach Lodge is available to book for a minimum of 1 guests and maximum 12 guests at ZAR 8030 per vehicle to get guests to Lekkerwater and back to Cape Town

#### ARRIVAL & DEPARTURE:

Guests should arrive at the lodge's car park with De Hoop for 14h00 Departure time from the lodge is scheduled for 10h30

#### PARK ENTRANCE:

Access to Lekkerwater is via the Potberg Park Entrance (not the "Morukuru and De Hoop Collection entrance gate"). From the Potberg entrance gate it is 14.8km (30-45 minutes' drive) to the lodge's car park. De Hoop Nature Reserve Gates open at 07h30 and close at 16h00. Gate entrance fee of ZAR 60 per person (estimated park fees subject to confirmation), per night is payable in cash upon entry. Please note that there are no credit card facilities available.

#### CHILDREN:

Children 6 and above are welcome
Children 6 - 18 years charged 50% of the adult rate per night (sharing with adults)
Children 19 years and over charged full adult rate

#### **BOOKING CONFIRMATIONS**

- · Provisional bookings can be held for a two-week period and are automatically released if not confirmed.
- A 20% non-refundable deposit is required to confirm a provisional booking.
- For confirmed bookings the balance of payment is required 60 days prior to travel.
- · If booking confirmation takes place within the 60-day period, the full amount is payable on confirmation of booking.
- Booking cancellations are subject to cancellation policy below.
- No booking will be cancelled or amended unless notified in writing.

Please Note: Payments must be made free of bank charges. Bank charges are for the account of the payer.

#### **BOOKING CANCELLATION POLICY**

The following cancellation policy applies to bookings for Natural Selection camps and services:

- 20% cancellation fee (deposit forfeit) from confirmation to 60 days prior to travel;
- 70% cancellation fee if cancelled 59 45 days prior to travel;
- 100% cancellation fee if cancelled 44 days or less prior to travel and any no-shows.

For Group Bookings: should the numbers in a group decrease after the booking has been confirmed, cancellation fees will be levied on the number of released beds. For bookings for third-party services, the relevant third-party terms and conditions will apply. These terms and conditions are available on request.

#### ORIGINATING AGENT

Natural Selection invests in international marketing activities. It is expected that agents supply details of their originating agents. Natural Selection reserves the right to reduce the agent commission by 5% (percentage points) if the originating agent is not supplied.
