Mike's career as a guide started at Londolozi in the 70s. He was already trained as a commercial pilot at that time and worked with John and Dave Varty until he moved to Botswana.

By the middle of '79 he was flying and guiding, taking mobile camping safaris into the Okavango Delta which was exciting and truly wild. He did that for several years before taking on more managerial roles with Gametrackers, Belmond and later Chobe Game Lodge.

In mid '95 he joined Wilderness Safaris as part of the team that built a great safari business over 23 years. While there, he started the Specialist Guide division which is today better known as Private Guiding and guided all over southern Africa. From the magnificent waterways and floodplains of the Okavango Delta to fishing off the vast dramatic Skeleton Coast. Up to the remote and ancient landscape of Damaraland in Namibia to the famous Victoria Falls, Hwange National Park, Matusadona and the Zambezi in Zimbabwe. The Busanga plains in Zambia has always been a highlight for him and he has spent time in Malawi. More recently, he guided a group in Tanzania in the Serengeti and Ruhaha.

Mike is also a passionate wildlife photographer, who over the years, has photographed and captured wild animals in the context of their natural habitat. He has seen many changes to our natural habitat, and these have all been documented in his book "My African Landscape".

Africa's wild spaces are now more important than ever, and their protection is so relevant to the well-being of our planet and humankind.
