Natural Selection cofounder Dr. Jennifer Lalley is a US born conservation biologist who has lived and worked in Africa for 27 years.

Originally employed in the Botswana tourism industry in the 1990's, she soon

shifted her focus to wildlife conservation, earning her master's degree at the

Durrell Institute for Conservation and Ecology and her PhD at Oxford University.

Moving between Botswana, Namibia and South Africa, she worked with non-

profits and government, ran a consulting company and lectured at the University

of Witwatersrand before co-founding the conservation tourism company Natural

Selection.

She currently resides in Botswana where she is a co-Director of the company and

chair of the Natural Selection Conservation Trust in Botswana and the US-based,

501c3 charity the Natural Selection Foundation.
