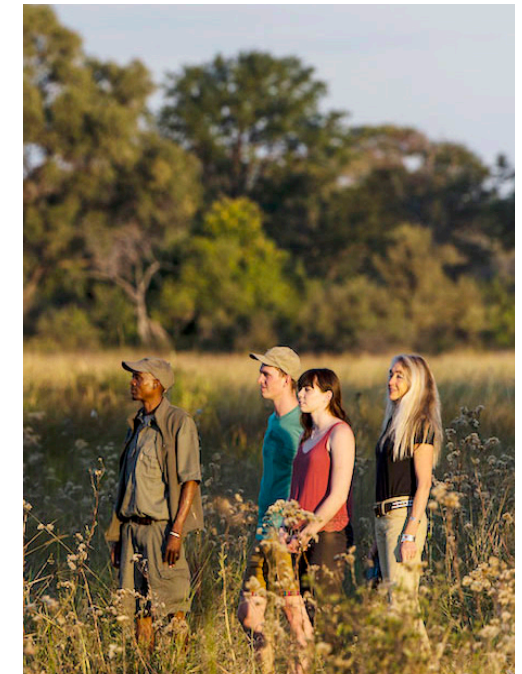

GAME DRIVES

All Natural Selection Camps

This is one activity that screams safari. Hop on our comfortable game viewing vehicles for a morning and afternoon/evening game drive. Your safari guide has all the expertise and knowledge to find you some of the best kept secrets and most loved wildlife in the Okavango Delta.

- *Children 6 years and older are welcome.*
- *Families travelling with children aged 9 years and younger require a private vehicle.*
- *Duration: approx. 3.5 hrs.*
- *All year round.*

KPR RANGER EXPERIENCE

Sable Alley, Tuludi, Little Sable, Elephant Pan

This engaging experience will get you heading out with the Khwai Private Reserve (KPR) rangers before dawn to track predators and fresh spoor. You'll spend 4-6 hours doing this, as well as collecting data, patrolling the area and checking on conservation projects en-route if time allows. Enjoy a packed lunch out in the bush with the rangers. They will get you back to camp before lunchtime.

- *Children 6 years and older are welcome.*
- *Duration: approx. 4-6 hrs.*
- *All year round.*
- *At an additional cost (proceeds of which will be allocated to conservation efforts in KPR).*

GUIDED WALKS

Elephant Pan, Skybeds, Tuludi, Sable Alley

Grab your comfiest walking shoes, and experience a guided walk through the bush with your trusted safari guide. You'll come across so many magical sightings, from the smallest critters, to beautiful trees and birds. Learn how to track spoor and identify the different grasses and other interesting fauna and flora that make up this beautiful eco-system.

- *Children 12 years and older are welcome.*
- *Duration: approx. 1-2 hrs.*
- *Seasonal.*

BOATING

Duke's Camp, Duke's East, North Island Okavango, Tuludi, Little Sable, Sable Alley, Mbamba

Jump on board our delta boats to cruise the Okavango waterways. Your experienced driver and guide will show you some of the best river sightings and sunsets. Keep a look out for birds, crocodiles, hippo and exciting game coming to quench their thirst, while you moor up along the river bank sipping a sundowner. This is what safari boat cruising is all about.

FISHING

A fabulous activity for families with kids. We're all about catch and release so ask your safari guide to hook you up with a couple of rods. Your experienced guide will pole you amongst the lily pads and weaving sandbanks, showing you the ebb and flow of this incredible eco-system.

- *Children 6 years and older are welcome.*
- *If fishing from a boat, children under 12 must wear a life jacket.*
- *Duration: approx. 1-2 hrs.*
- *Seasonal.*

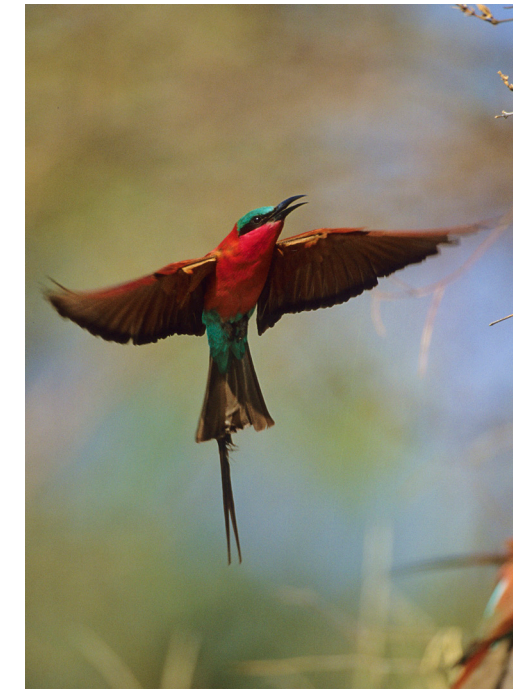


MOKORO TRIPS

Duke's Camp, Duke's East, North Island Okavango, Tuludi, Sable Alley, Little Sable, Mokolwane, Mbamba

This is one of the most iconic Okavango Delta experiences. Wind your way around the crystal-clear waterways on mokoro. Your experienced guide, will pole you amongst the lily pads and weaving sandbanks, to show you the ebbs and flows of this incredible eco-system.

- *Children 6 years and older are welcome.*
- *Children under 12 must wear a life jacket.*
- *Duration: approx. 2 hrs.*
- *Seasonal.*



BIRD WATCHING

All Natural Selection Camps

Calling all bird lovers! Bring your binos, your bird book and your Natural Selection birding checklist to enjoy a birding safari in the Okavango Delta. Your safari guide will show you spectacular birds, and is at the ready to answer all your birding questions.

VIEWING HIDE

Tuludi, Elephant Pan, Skybeds, Sable Alley*, Little Sable**

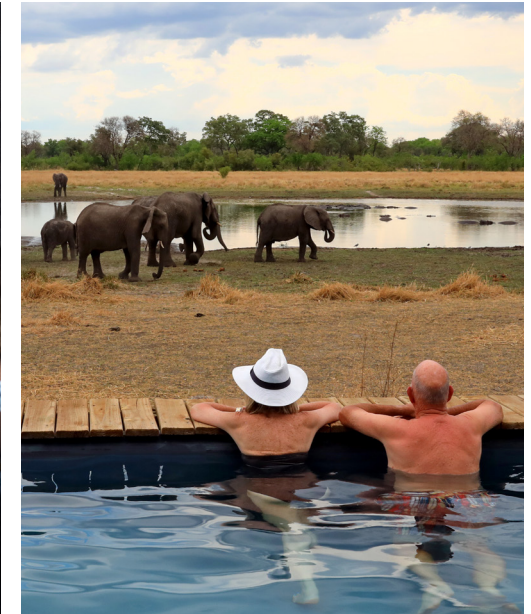
A visit to our underground viewing hides (we have two), is definitely a must-see and a highlight for most guests. Experience intimate eye-to-eye encounters with a wild variety of thirsty visitors while in a safe structure. Each sunken hide is built at a bustling waterhole, with comfy game viewing chairs on which to perch, and enjoy the view.

HELI FLIGHTS

Duke's Camp, Duke's East, North Island Okavango, Tuludi, Little Sable, Sable Alley, Elephant Pan, Mokolwane, Tawana, Mbamba

Enjoy a scenic helicopter flight over the Okavango Delta. This is an incredible opportunity to appreciate the vastness of the Delta when seeing it from above. From your seat, door off (or on), you'll be able to spot game, take exceptional photos and follow the waterways and animal pathways that shape this ancient wilderness.

- *Duration: 30 min, 45 min and 1hr options available on request.*
- *All year round.*
- *At an additional cost.*

SWIMMING POOLS

SLEEPOUTS

SKYBEDS*: *Tuludi, Elephant Pan, Little Sable, Sable Alley*

FLY-CAMPING: *Duke's Camp, Duke's East,*

Uncharted Expeditions Camp

If you're looking for the ultimate romantic adventure, then this activity will leave you totally starstruck. Spend an enchanting evening safely tucked up in one of our raised sleepouts, or fly-camping on an island at Duke's Camp and Duke's East. This activity will get you listening to the sounds of the African bush at night, while covered in a blanket of a billion stars.

**Access from Tuludi, Sable Alley and Little Sable is by heli to Elephant Pan, with an onward road transfer to Skybeds.*

- *Usually 1 Apr – 31 Oct, dry months only. Weather permitting.*
- *Duration – 1 night.*
- *At additional cost.*
- *SKYBEDS: Children 16 years and older may stay on a platform on their own. If booked exclusively, children aged 12 to 15 are allowed to share a platform with an adult.*
- *FLY-CAMPING: Can be booked on a minimum 2-night stay at Duke's Camp or Duke's East, although 3 nights is preferable. Children aged 12 years and older may take part in the overnight island fly-camping experience.*

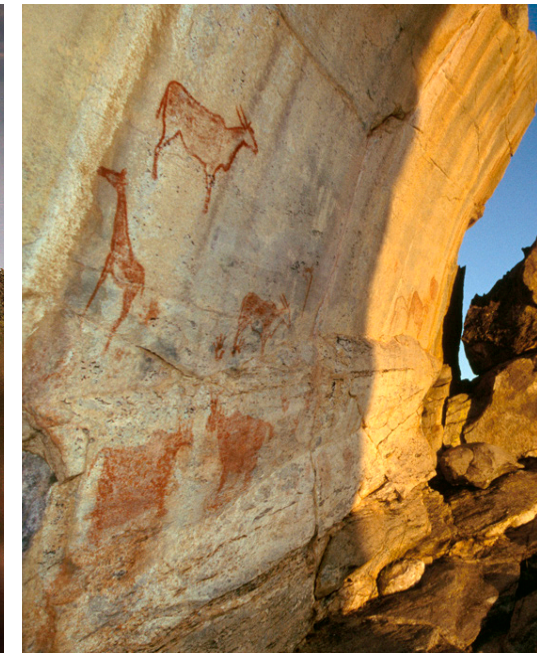
SPA TREATMENTS

Duke's Camp, Duke's East, Tawana, Tuludi, Sable Alley,

North Island Okavango, Meno A Kwena

If you are needing a little me time, then this is the perfect activity. Book a back massage or enjoy a relaxing spa treatment while in between game drives and wildlife adventures. This is safari self-indulgence without any guilt allowed.

KHWAI VILLAGE VISIT

Tuludi, Sable Alley, Little Sable, Elephant Pan

Visit Khwai Village to learn about local culture, history and traditions of the local community - including the Kgotla (meeting place in the village). Enjoy interactions with the teachers and children of Khwai Pre-Primary School and meet the ladies doing traditional basket weaving. The Kachokachoka, a traditional healer, will share their knowledge of traditional medicine and local beliefs.

Tour can only be booked once guests are in camp (no pre-bookings). There are strict dress guidelines when entering the Kgotla to show respect. Book a consultation with the traditional healer (additional cost).

- *Children 6 years and older are welcome.*
- *Duration: approx. 3hrs.*
- *All year round; week days only.*
- *Tuludi guests can opt for a heli transfer (additional cost).*

TSODILO HILLS CULTURAL TRIP

Duke's Camp, North Island Okavango, Duke's East, Mbamba

Experience a trip to Tsodilo Hills, a World Heritage Site in the Northern Okavango Delta. The hills are home to more than 4,000 San Bushman paintings – probably the most important rock art in Africa! Several walking trails provide helpful routes around the painting sites.

Access from Duke's is by heli and by boat from Okavango Spirit Houseboat. Additional costs apply.

- *Children 6 years and older are welcome.*
- *Duration: approx. 2 hrs.*
- *All year round.*
